# Furry Gender Affirming Care: Deerfolk!

I'm a furry, and I think about gender affirming care all the time... so naturally my mind would wander to what gender affirming care would look like in a world where we are all anthropomorphic animals!!!

In this article (if you could even call it that, it's just me rambling about furry gender affirming care haha), I will be focusing on anthropomorphic deer (or any animal in the Cervidae family), and gender affirming care surrounding their unique secondary sex characteristic: antlers!

## Transfeminine/Buck to Doe Deerfolk

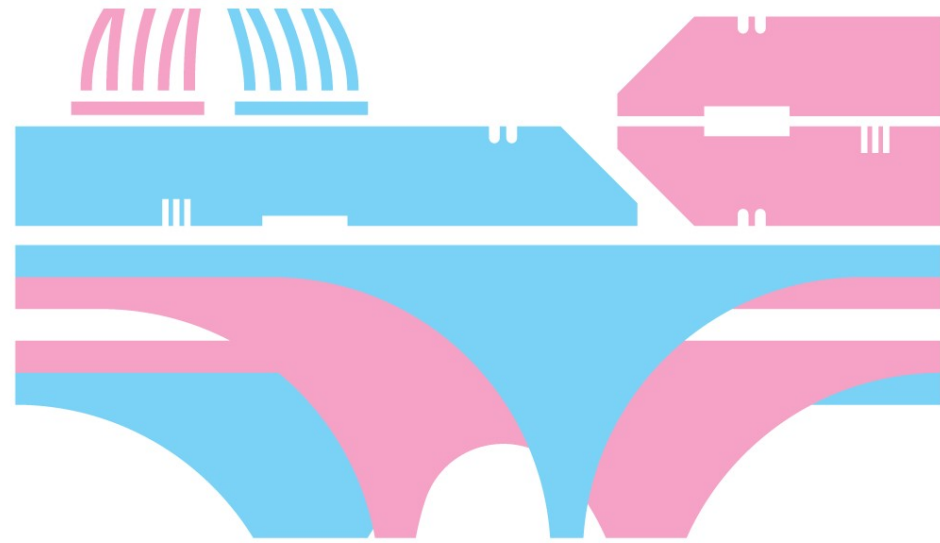
For most deerfolk born male, antlers start to grow when there is a boost in hormones (Badder, 2025), so I would assume in Furry World™ the growth of antlers would occur during puberty, instead of occurring yearly when bioavailable food sources are rich, because in this modern age, we can basically get whatever we want from supermarkets!! Antlers will start to bud with velvet around the ages of 10-12, with growth spiking around 12-17 where testosterone in teenage males increases, and slowing down from 17 onwards, when testosterone levels start to plateau (Kelsey et al. 2014).

Antlers naturally shed when testosterone levels decline, so when a BTD (buck to doe) individual starts feminising HRT or Testosterone blockers, it would be correct to assume that their antlers will shed naturally within the first few months since the growth of antlers is tied to an increase in testosterone (Price, 2025). However, in the case of individuals that are unable to start feminising HRT, or who choose not to, but still wish to rid themselves of their antlers, they can choose to surgically remove their antlers. They may choose to remove their antlers just above the base so that they may grow back, or, they can choose to remove their pedicles, permanent bony protuberances on the frontal bone (Price et al., 2005) which are essentially the bud from which antlers grow, resulting in permanent antler loss. This procedure, like many gender affirming surgeries in real life, isn't restricted to just BTD individuals!

## Transmasculine/Doe to Buck Deerfolk

For most deerfolk born female, their secondary sex characteristics would not differ from humans, since they are anthropomorphic deer. They may seek the same gender affirming surgeries FTM folk do in our world, with the addition of antler implants! Now, there have been cases of female deer in this world growing antlers (albeit small ones, or just a singular one), as a result of hormonal imbalances that may have led to an increase in testosterone (Hill, 2021), however, the source of this information is a hunting company, and not a scientific paper. Assuming that testosterone can stimulate antler growth, regular HRT with testosterone can allow DTB (doe to buck) individuals to grow their own antlers!

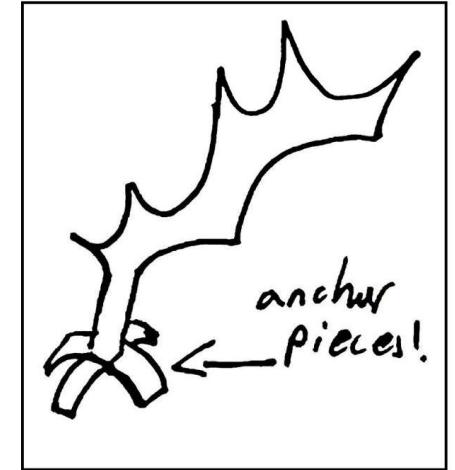

I do not know enough about intersex humans to comment on this or explain how this would work for intersex deerfolk, as I said earlier, it is entirely dependent on the individual!

## Relaxing in Fantasy Dragon's Dogma 2

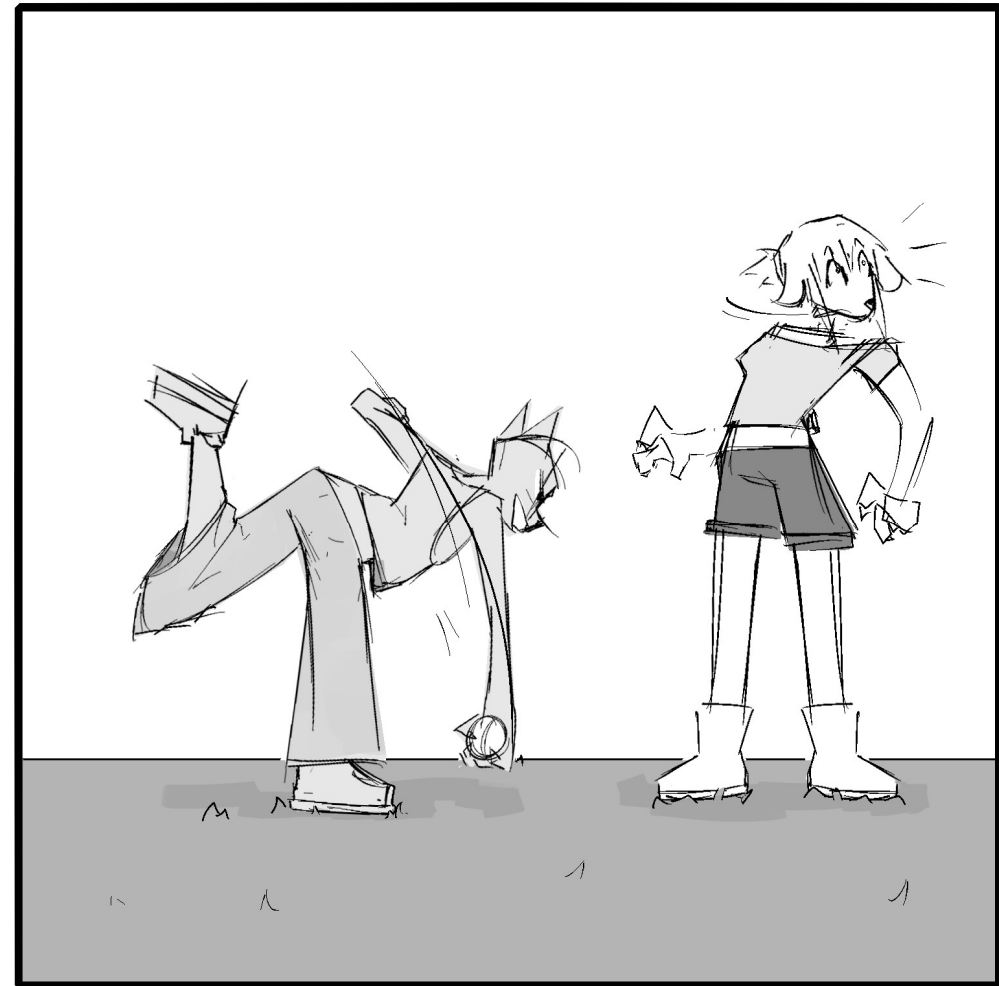
